

- 1. Find best path to run main loom and roughly tie up with cable ties.
- 2. Run centre loom down centre wire harness path
- 3. Rear lights can be either fitted on tray or rear of roof.
- 4. Power and earth will pick up from busbar terminals under dash
- 5. Looms on some machines may be longer to allow for universal fitment and may need tied up.
- 6. Front loom runs through firewall to mount indicators.
- 7. Indicators must be more than 300mm apart to be legal in most states.
- 8. Where you can, run all wiring under plastic covers along sides of units.
- 9. Drill 18mm holes for indicator plugs and fix indicators with self tapping screws.
- 10. Fit number plate light next to or under number plate
- 11. Mount rocker switch in dash
- 12. Beacon power is picked up from roof power on can am
- 13. Make sure all wires are tied up and can't be ripped out when in use.
- 14. Test all lights and that switch is orientated properly
- 15. Make sure all wiring is fitted by a qualified mechanic or auto electrician
- 16. For best location if possible fit rear indicators and number plate light to back of roof
